

I thought there is still hope for a person when the person is still alive to repent from unbelief towards belief.

Of course I am not the one who decides if a person will be saved or not, have a place in the home of God or not. That is why the farthest I will go is to say the probability is high or low, or chances are good or not so good. I certainly have no way of knowing.

What I do know is that the Lord will make the ultimate decision concerning who He will resurrect or not, and I think people can look more towards Scriptural references, rather than the person of our God. I am of course not wanting to discourage Scriptural references, but I have gotten the sense that a lot of people are preparing to argue with God if He doesn't let them in when they die. I would not expect that to go well.

I have known of a lot of people who reject the Lord their whole lives. They definitely end their lives with a deep sense of emptiness, resentment, and they have a hard time not blaming God for the disappointing life they had. Some can certainly decide they want to be with Him in eternity, but it can easily be more of a decision of not wanting to go to Hell than a decision about being with and knowing the Lord. So, the Lord

can certainly hear their prayer, and hear them tell Him something like this, "I lived my whole life rejecting you, and if I were to live longer, I would still likely reject you for those additional years. I have no interest in knowing you personally, but since I don't want to go to Hell, I will say I repent and believe in you now, so you can let me in, and I will just find some peaceful place to hang out in your Kingdom while you occupy yourself with others." I certainly don't know, but I suspect He might hesitate to respond to something like that. That's what I was thinking.

#### Psalm 51:11 & John 7:39

In John 7:39 we read, ... the Holy Spirit was not yet given but in Ps 51:11 David says, ... take not your Holy Spirit from me.

I have heard different views on this, but I would appreciate your thoughts on it.

In John 7, it was about salvation In Ps 51 it was about the presence of God in his life.

This is my general view, Still, I hesitate establishing doctrine from the lyrics of songs.

*Isn't the presence of God in our lives salvation?* 

God was present with the children of Israel in the desert, but they certainly were not saved by being born again into a new creation through being made alive by the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit. Those are two completely different things.
