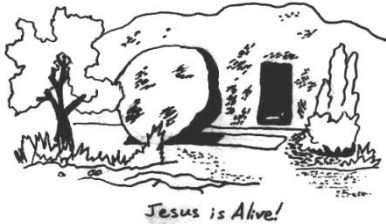

Correspondence

I read your testimony on the Living God Ministries website and felt inspired to tell you that I've been saved, and to ask you for more information that will help me in my growth in my relationship with God, through the Lord Jesus Christ.

Mind you.....I've never read a bible, scripture, testament, etc. I don't even know the real meaning of those words! So, every information I will receive I will gratefully accept and try to make sense of. Is there help available in case I simply don't understand the language used, or is it part of my journey to figure all this out by myself?

I will never forget working through this question myself. I had been studying for years, but had a pivotal moment when I thought it was either going to be a lifetime commitment, or I was just going to abandon all thoughts of the things of God from then on. I looked around and saw the plants and animals around me. I recognized it was impossible for them to exist without a designer of some kind, so I considered that to be enough evidence for me to commit to the belief in Him from then on without any reservation. It was not proof, but it was enough evidence for me to move forward with.

The first thing I would probably share would be to encourage you to just take your time. Yes, it is a whole new vocabulary and culture, but you'll figure out most of it in no time. Don't make any serious decisions or commitments right away. If you consider 1000 different churches in your local area, that could imply 999 of them are not correct. And when you consider those odds, it doesn't look so good for the last one either. Don't let anyone pressure you into believing one thing or the other. Make notes, and patiently wait. From there, consider the puzzle illustration. If you look at a 100,000 piece puzzle, it can take a long time to put together. It can be even more difficult to do it without the picture on the box. It's the same thing here. The Scriptures can be like a huge collection of verses that are each like puzzle pieces. Without the picture on the box, it is just going to take a lot longer to figure out where they all go and fit. If you start with the Gospel I described, you will have a really good outline of the whole picture, and this will help more than you can imagine.

The radio programs I recorded were mainly for

people who already had a religious background of some kind. I spend a lot of time working on the barriers people have in their lives because of things they believe that are not true. The programs I recorded on the Gospel of John recently were designed for someone in your situation. With the coming world war, I recorded them, expecting a lot of new people to search for God in the coming years. I have a YouTube channel where I posted a version for home Bible studies. From there, the programs in the first section of the radio archive would be really good to spend some time in. This is where most of the historical contributions I have made are found, and will give you a lot of background into why Jesus was teaching and doing the things He was.

Do feel free to write me any time with questions. I may be delayed sometimes in responding, but I will always do what I can to give you an answer of some kind.

More questions

When people start reading through the New Testament, they often notice right away there are two different genealogies listed. I recorded that program to explain it to them. Most of the recordings I have done are for those who already have a Christian background of some kind, mainly because I had funding to go on radio and that has been my main audience.

Overall, this whole subject is going to feel really big, but give it time, use a layered approach, and it gets smaller and smaller, more real and less abstract.

With regards to feeling a connection with God, this is a common way for people to at least get started, but do know that if you rely on your feelings, you are, "doomed." Our God is a person, not an abstract philosophy that gives us good feelings. You will have to turn to facts and truth, and this has very little connection to feelings. Many truths will make you feel uncomfortable and give you awkward feelings,

but that is a reflection of our dysfunction, not God's.

Churches are set up to run as businesses. To understand that up front will help you navigate through them easier. They survive mainly on subtle forms of extortion, such as, "give me your money or God will punish you." Without that, the percentages of people to enough income just won't enable them to continue to operate. The ministry I set up for radio is an exception, where the model is that people give so others can benefit as they already have. This is gradually discontinuing as the world economy changes and people will have much less to donate. I expected this and have been organized for this since the beginning, which is why the radio archive page is set up in the way it is. I am about to start building a for profit model separately with books and conferences, so I can continue in the ministry a little longer. A church is a great way to meet new people, enjoy somewhat of a religious entertainment center, but in general, the teaching will at best be to try and bury you under a life of repentance and obedience, instead of faith and trust in what He has already done for you.

When it comes to the Bible itself, I use the New King James Version, and some of the programs were recorded with the New American Standard. I do have a radio program in the archive on translations you should listen to. For now, you should just approach it as a text of history. It is a record of what God said and did, so do find out what happened, and what He had to say. It becomes a layered approach from there. Let me give you a few examples of the layered issues.

The first is why did He bother with all of this at all. My sincere opinion is that the Lord wants people in His life, who are in His life and know who He is because they genuinely want to be in His life and know who He is. For this to be possible, He had to design the planet in the way He did so people could choose to reject His existence and occupy themselves well enough

for their whole lives. What He gets is a very small percentage of people from each generation, but it is better than having no one from each generation.

The second, which of course is just a continuation from the first, are the problems that resulted from the decision of Adam and Eve to eat from the tree God wanted to have in the garden just for Himself. The spiritual death issue had to be resolved, and that was resolved through the resurrection of the Messiah, Jesus. The other issue was a new question of do we now live by the knowledge of good and evil or is that impossible. The entire history from there up until the crucifixion was about answering this question of living according to the knowledge of good and evil. He let people try to figure it out on their own, and then eventually made His contribution through giving a law through Moses. The children of Israel tried and failed, and again and again, and this is the Old Testament. You will find Him relating to them in the wilderness as just one big conflict. Everything was defined in terms of willful voluntary behavior. If they did then He would do. If He did then they would do. This was establishing the stage for generations to try and live a life they were not created to live, just to answer the question of do we live by the law or knowledge of good and evil or not. When the people finally believed they succeeded at being completely obedient to God, He personally showed up as Jesus to tell them He was still not impressed. That was the ministry for Jesus.

The New Testament, after the Gospel of John, was the struggle of the early church to discover the implications of what Jesus did through the crucifixion and resurrection. Paul figured it out, while Peter, James and John only figured out some of it. We have their letters to understand the differences of their understanding.

When it comes to other people who are a part of different spiritual systems, like Hare Krishna, most of them embrace these philosophies as an alternative to Christianity. They are for the most

part against Christian religion that was abusive, and not so much in the pursuit of truth.
